- 1. Directly observable
- 2. Within most children's experiences
- 3. Firsthand direct investigation is feasible
- 4. Local resources are available.
- 5. Has potential for representation
- 6. Parental participation is likely
- 7. Sensitive to local culture
- 8. Interesting to many children
- 9. Related to curriculum goals
- 10. Opportunities to apply basic skills
- 11. Not too narrow or broad
- 12. Interesting to the teacher
