

Definitions

Regenerative - bring into renewed existence, generate again, enhance bring new and more vigorous life to something

Emergence– An emergence is when something comes into view – like the emergence of a seedling in a garden

Collective leadership – working with others – leadership is a set of behaviors and practices regardless of job title or role


