# Get close, move around

Ensure everything in the frame has meaning. Move around so unwanted elements are blocked by the subject or out of the frame.

# Get down to child level

Look through a child's eyes and notice overlooked details by shooting at their eye level or below.



### Involve children

Support children in taking their own photos to capture their view of the world.

### **Record processes**

Show a process like creating an artwork by taking a series of photos or by using your device's timelapse feature.





## Don't forget video

Video is a rich, accurate and fast way to share what occurred and encourages family engagement.

Keep devices in a dedicated place, batteries charged and lenses clean. Keep videos **under 3-mins** or 300MB so they upload fast. Reduce video quality in device settings. **Keep light behind or beside you** so subjects aren't silhouetted. More light = clear photos, no blur.

Always take photos in landscape mode? **Turn your device** to portrait. And vice versa. Take a few shots to make sure you captured the moment and delete what you don't use later.
